Aspects of military pilot flight training for the new generation of aircraft to be introduced in the next 10 years are very complex and include a number of technological and tactical innovations. These aircraft bring revolutionary changes to military aviation, including advanced stealth technologies, shape-shifting capabilities, high levels of computer connectivity and situational awareness through sensitive sensors and smart surface technology. Pilot training must reflect these new features and prepare pilots for the challenges of flying these aircrafts. Pilot training for the fifth and sixth generation aircraft focuses on developing decision-making capabilities in a highly complex combat environment.


